Frequently Asked Questions

SST-2025

Q1. What is SST-2025?

Ans:- SST-2025 stands for Singhal-Stars Scholars Test conducted to test the knowledge of the children of classes 1 to 12.

Q2. Who can appear in SST-2025?

Ans:- Any child studying in classes 1st to 12th (AY 2024-25) of any CBSE/ICSE school can appear in SST-2025.

Q3. What are the benefits of SST-2025?

Ans:- It has many benefits for children of all the schools. We list some of them below:

It will test a child's performance in different subjects in one go. A child will come to know where he stands, not only among his classmates but also the students of whole of Mansa city and surrounding areas including Maur, Bhikhi, Budhlada etc. Every candidate will be informed about his marks and rank on or before 25th December 2024.

Children standing 1st, 2nd and 3rd in classes from 1st to 12th will be given a cash prize of Rs 5000/-, Rs 3000/- and Rs 2000/- respectively. There will be separate prize for each of the four streams of classes 11 & 12. But a student of classes 11th & 12th must score more than 75% marks to be eligible for a prize. The total cash prize amount is of Rs 1 lakh 80 thousand.

Meritorious students will also be awarded medals and certificates.

Q4. How do I register myself for SST-2025?

Ans:- You may register yourself for SST-2025 in any one of the two ways. Both the ways are explained below:

Offline: You can visit the following schools and collect the Registration Form between

10:30 am and 1:30 pm.

When you visit any of the above schools to collect the Registration Form then please bring two passport size photographs of the child and one copy of ID proof of the child (DOB certificate or Aadhaar Card or School ID Card). This will enable you to submit the Registration Form without having to visit the school again. You can deposit the filled in Registration Form in any of the above schools from Monday to Saturday between 10:30 am and 1:30 pm along with the Registration Fee of Rs 100/-. You will be given the Registration No. and Admit Card of your child immediately.

Online: There are two options for online applicants.

Option A

Step 1: You should download and print the Registration Form from the school website: <u>www.singhalstars.com</u> by clicking on the link SST-2025.

STEP 2: You should fill the Registration Form and Admit Card and submit it in any one of the 4 schools listed above in the Offline Option along with Rs 100/-. The Admit Card printed at the bottom of the form will be stamped and you will be given the Registration No. immediately.

Option B

STEP 1: You should visit the school website: <u>www.singhalstars.com</u> and click on the link SST-2025. You should fill in the Registration Form Online and submit the same. You will be required to upload your PP size photograph.

STEP 2: Please print your Admit Card after you submit the Registration Form. You are not required to pay any Registration Fee when you print the Admit Card.

STEP 3: Please pay the Registration Fee of Rs 100/- when you visit the Test Centre on the day of SST-2025.

Please note that candidates who choose Option B are required to report at 9:30 am at the Test Centre so that they have enough time to submit the Registration Fee. Option B has been specially designed for parents/children who do not want to visit any of the four Test Centres/Schools before the test.

Please also note that the Online Options A & B are available to students who are not studying in Singhal Stars School. Students of Singhal Stars School are required to register offline only.

Q5. What is the last date for registration?

Ans:- The last date for registration is 29th November (Friday).

Q6. When will be SST-2025 conducted?

Ans:- SST-2025 will be conducted on 1st December (Sunday) from 11 am to 1 pm.

Q7. What will be the reporting time?

Ans:- Students who have registered Offline or have used Option A for Online Registration have to report at 10:00 am.

Students who have used Option 2 for Online Registration will report at 9:30 am as they have to pay Rs 100/- as Registration Fee on the day of test.

Q9. For which subjects will I be tested in SST-2025?

Ans:- Students of classes 1 to 5 will be tested in English, Hindi, Punjabi and Maths.

Students of classes 6 to 8 will be tested in English, Hindi, Punjabi, Maths and Science.

Students of classes 9 & 10 will be tested in English, Hindi, Punjabi, Maths, Science and Social Science.

Students of classes 11 & 12 (Medical) will be tested in English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

Students of classes 11 & 12 (Non-Medical) will be tested in English, Physics, Chemistry and Maths.

Students of classes 11 & 12 (Commerce) will be tested in English, Accountancy, Business Studies and Economics.

Students of classes 11 & 12 (Arts) will have to choose any three subjects from History, Political Science, Economics, Psychology and Maths. They will be tested in three subjects of their choice and English.

English is Compulsory for all the students of all streams of classes 11 & 12.

Q10. What sort of questions will be there in the exam?

Ans :- You may download sample papers of different subjects from the school website. For this:

1. Click on the link SST-2025. A drop down list will appear.

2. Click on Sample Papers and download the sample paper of whichever class and subject you need.

Q11. What stationery do I need to bring for the exam?

Ans:- Students of classes 1 to 4 must bring 3 sharpened pencils and one eraser. Students of classes 5 to 12 must bring blue gel pens only.

Q12. How do I register my phone no to receive the result and other information about SST-2025?

Ans:- You should save the WhatsApp number **9988685084** of the school on the phone on which your WhatsApp number given to us is active. You will be added in the WhatsApp Group specially created for SST-2025. Only then you will be able to receive the message sent by us on WhatsApp.

Q13. How will I come to know about my marks and rank in SST-2025?

Ans:- You will be informed about your marks and rank in SST-2025 through WhatsApp message on the phone number mentioned in your Registration Form.
